Fall BOW Workshop

A ONE-DAY FALL BOW WORKSHOP WILL BE HELD ON
SEPTEMBER 11 , 2021 • 9:00 AM - 3:00 PM
Owl Brook Hunter Education Center • Holderness, NH

COURSE DESCRIPTIONS - *Participants will select one course.*

HIKING AND WILDLIFE WATCHING: While hiking the Owl Brook 500-acre property, look for wildlife sign, learn about safe hiking practices, and how to take a compass setting. You will hike to the Button (a 2.5-mile round trip) located on the Owl Brook property.

FLY FISHING A-Z: Learn the basics of fly fishing from rods and reels to knot tying and casting. Other topics covered include exploring a stream, picking a proper fly and knowing how to cast it, and what to do when you catch a fish—playing, landing, and releasing. This is a hands-on class both inside and outside. There will not be fishing on the water in this class.

LAND NAVIGATION: Learn how to read topographic maps and use a compass to go anywhere. This class is hands on and everyone will get a chance to navigate the map and compass course at the Owl Brook Hunter Education Center.

INTRO TO ARCHERY AND BOWHUNTING: Explore the fun of archery shooting with expert guidance from our archery instructors. After learning to shoot with archery equipment, you will also learn a little about Bowhunting and have the opportunity to shoot 3D targets.

IMPORTANT BOW REGISTRATION INFORMATION

REGISTRATION ONLINE ONLY: Registration opens July 30, 2021. Go to nhbow.com where you will be directed to the event registration page. Payment and accompanying forms must be received at Fish and Game headquarters by August 16, 2021. If the program is full, check back often to see if spaces have opened up through cancellations.

REGISTRATION CONFIRMATION: Upon being registered, you will be sent an email confirmation. Once your payment is received, you will be sent an information e-package (directions to Owl Brook, an agenda for the day, and a list of what to bring). *If we do not receive your payment by August 16, 2021, your name will be REMOVED from the roster.*

CANCELLATION POLICY: If you cancel by 12:00 p.m. August 30, 2021, you will receive a full refund. *Registrants who do not attend and who do not cancel by this date will not receive a refund.* You may send a substitute in your place; please advise us by calling (603) 271-3212 if you choose to do this by August 30, 2021.

CHECK-IN TIME: Please **arrive between 8:00-8:30** a.m. for check-in. Classes begin promptly at 9:00 a.m. There will be no large gathering before classes begin. After registration you will head to your class. Classes will be held outdoors for most of the day, so dress accordingly.

FEE: \$85 Includes instruction in all sessions, program materials, use of demonstration equipment, and lunch. *Fee due with registration forms.*

BOW MERCHANDISE: There will be some BOW merchandise for sale at the event. More information will be sent in your confirmation e-packet. Cash, checks, and credit cards accepted.

RAFFLE: You will have the opportunity to purchase raffle tickets for \$1 each or 25 for \$20. You could win outdoor gear and other great prizes. Cash, checks, and credit cards accepted.
